

CHILDREN AND HIGH HOLY DAYS

Our “Service for Families with Young Children” geared to Preschoolers through Grade Two takes place on both Holy Days during the early afternoon. All ages are welcome - especially grandparents. These services are open to the community. No tickets needed.

We are pleased to offer our Pre-K through Grade 4 **CHILDREN’S HIGH HOLY DAY ENRICHMENT PROGRAM** for both Rosh Hashanah (Monday, September 10th) and Yom Kippur (Wednesday, September 19th) while adults and older children are in the Sanctuary. Guests who have High Holy Day Tickets are also eligible to use these programs. Pre-Registration is required for all children. This program has age appropriate activities focused on the holiday, including a brief service for the oldest children.

The early service on both days allows our families and older children (5th grade and up) to worship together in the Sanctuary while younger children (Pre-K to 4th grade) are having an Enrichment Experience in the classrooms. The older children and teens will be involved in the main adult service in meaningful ways.

We highly recommend our Enrichment Program, which usually has been attended by the majority of our children, but as always, children of any age are welcome in the Sanctuary. **We ask if you are not using the Enrichment Program that you take breaks as needed with your younger children and maintain decorum during the service. For their own safety and that of our building, children and teens may not be left without a parent in the hallways or lobby at any time.**

PRE-K THROUGH FOURTH GRADE ENRICHMENT PROGRAM DETAILS

- Minimum age: 3-1/2 years old; maximum age: Grade 4.
- Only pre-registered children will be admitted to the Enrichment Program
- Drop-off is between 10:00 AM and 10:30 AM. Check in by School Entrance. Please arrive on time so that the group leaders can welcome our children and begin the activities.
- Accompany your child to classroom assigned and sign your child in with the group leader.
- Please advise the group leader by means of a written note about any food allergies, medications or special needs when you drop off your child or indicate this on the registration form below.
- On Rosh Hashanah, all children come to the Sanctuary for Shofar Blowing.
- On Yom Kippur, children remain in downstairs programming until end of main service at approximately 12:30 pm.
